CONTENTS:

- Game board
- 180 I Am cards
- 20 movement cards
- 4 game pieces
- 4 headbands

AIM OF THE GAME
Take turns trying to guess who or what you are, while all the other players explain it together.
When you guess your character correctly, you can move forward on the track.
The player, who moves around the game board first, wins!

SETUP

1. Place a playing piece in the starting space on the game board for each player.
2. Separate the movement cards from the I Am cards and shuffle each deck.
3. Place the movement cards next to the game board with the diamond side down, and place the I Am cards next to the game board with the ALIAS side up.
4. Put on your headbands!
5. The oldest player is the first to guess. The other players place a card in that player's headband so he or she does not see the picture on it at all but all the other players can see it!

HOW TO PLAY

1. All the other players explain to the player in turn and try to make that player guess WHO or WHAT he or she is! Try not to talk over each other, so that everyone gets to help!
When you're explaining, don't use the word or any part of it!
2. If the word is too difficult to guess, you can skip it, stick a new card in the headband and start to explain the new word to the player in turn. Used and skipped cards go into the discard pile.
3. When the player in turn guesses the word right, he or she can turn the top movement card and move his or her playing piece on the game board, to the next space with a matching picture on it!

Place the used movement card in
 a separate discard pile.
4. The player on the left of the previous player is in turn next. Put a card in their headband and the game continues.
Note! When the movement cards run out, shuffle the discard pile and use it again!

END OF THE GAME
The first player to move his or her game piece once around the game board and back to the start space wins!
